He is a graduate of Cambridge University in England. He retired from the consulting firm Milliman in December 2007 after a 43 year career. He was a consulting actuary in the Philadelphia, Boston, and London offices of Milliman. He began his actuarial career with Milliman in Seattle in 1964 and served in the IT department from 1965 - 1986.

He was a board member of the US Actuarial Standards Board 2004 - 2009 (Vice Chair 2006 – 2009). He was a member, vice chair, and chair of the Actuarial Standards Committee of the IAA from its formation in 2010 to 2018.

He was a member of the ABCD 2017 – 2022.

He served on the SOA E&E committee 1978- 1989 (General Chair 1989) and several other SOA committees and task forces,

He served on the Life Practice, Professionalism, and Risk Management and Financial Reporting Councils, and the Board of the Academy.
